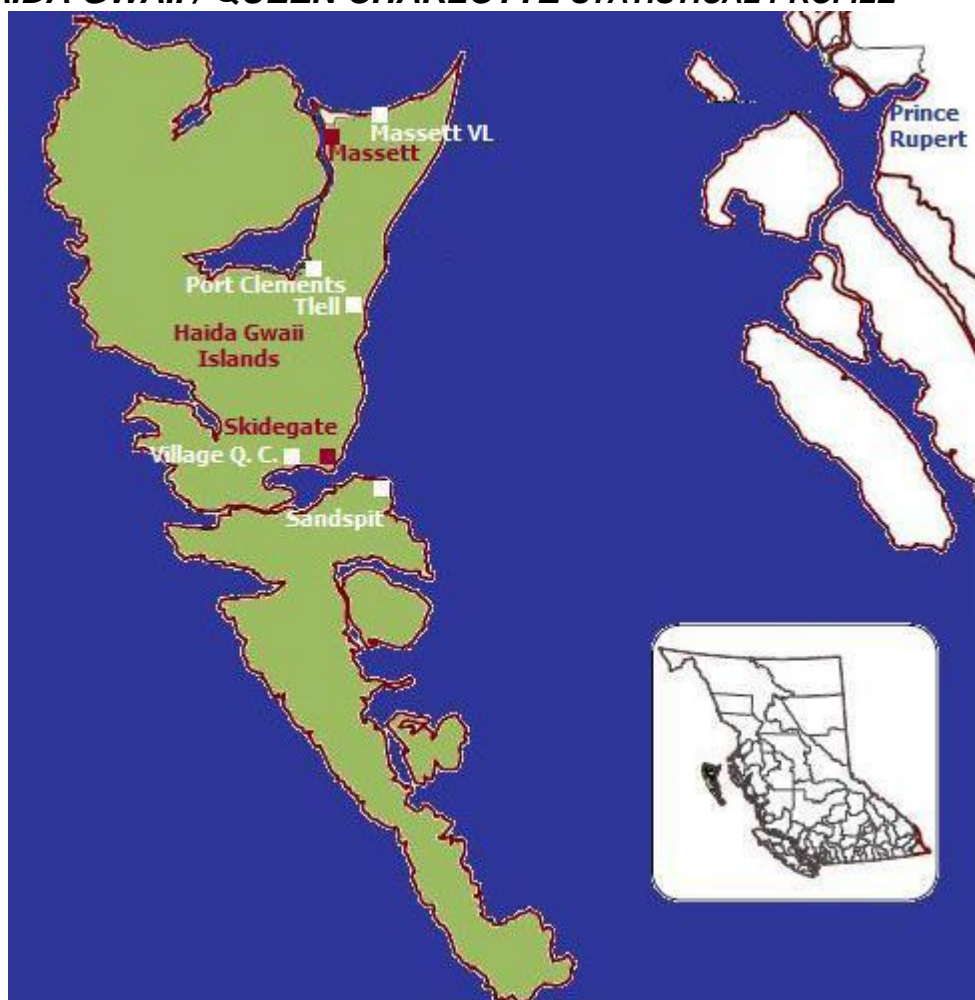

## Families 180

**Husband-Wife families 120** (67% of 180 Total Families)

Now-married couples 75 (or 58% of 120 Total)

Without child\* at home 33%

With children\* at home 67%

Common-law couples 50 (or 42% of 120 Total)

Without child\* at home 30% \*

With children\* at home 60% \*

*Error Data \* Addition should be 100% not 90% (60+30)*

**Single-parent families 60** (33% of 180 Total Families)

Male parent 25% \*

Female parent 83% \*\*

*Error Data \* – if Single-Male parents are 25% then Single Female Parents ought to be 75%.*

*\*\* – If Single-Female Parents are 83% then Single-Male parents ought to be 17%.*

- Native Massett shows 180 families with 120 "couples" (married/Common-law) and 60 Single-Parent families with 1-3 and more children.
- **33%** of the families in Native Massett **are Single-Parent homes** with 25% (or 17%?) Single-Male Parents and 83% (or 75%?) Single-Female Parents.
- The **Single-Parent Families and the Common-law Couples total 110 families or 61%** of Total 180 Families.

## Families 220

**Husband-Wife families 165** (or 75% of 220 Total)

Now-married couples 105\* (ought to be 61% of 165 Total)

Without child\* at home 48%

With children\* at home 52%

*\* Error Data: 105 +65 ought to be 165 not 170*

Common-law couples 65 \* (or 39% of 165 Total)

Without child\* at home 38% \*\*

With children\* at home 69% \*\* *\*\* Error Data \* Addition should be 100% not 107% (38+69)*

**Single-parent families 55** (25% of 220 Total Families)

Male parent 18 %

Female parent 82%

- Native Skidegate shows 220 families with 165 "couples" (married/Common-law) and 55 Single-Parent families with 1-3 and more children.
- **25%** of the families in Native Massett **are Single-Parent homes** with 18% Single-Male Parents and 82% Single-Female Parents.
- The **Single-Parent Families and the Common-law Couples total 120 families or 55%** of Total 2200 Families.
